GUIDELINES

1. Application form should be duly filled by the applicant in his/her own handwriting.
2. Candidates belonging to SC/ST, shall have to put tick mark in the respective box.
3. Entries in all columns should be filled in neatly.
4. Candidates desirous of hostel accommodation should mark "HOSTEL" at the top corner of the application form in RED INK.
5. A candidate must clearly mention in full the class to which he/she seeks admission.

DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED ALONG WITH APPLICATION FORM

1. Processing Fee of Rs 100/- (One Hundred Rupee Only) to be submitted at college counter.
2. Mark Sheet(s) of qualifying examination(FINAL DEGREE)
3. 10th Class certificate (or equivalent) for date of birth.
4. Caste certificate (in case of SC/ST candidates) from competent authority not below the rank of Tahsildar.
5. No objection certificate from the employer given in the application form (in case of employed candidate).
6. One passport size photograph self-attested on the front side to be affixed on the space provided in the application form.

PRINCIPLE OF SELECTION

1. Selection of candidate to various classes shall be strictly on merit basis.
2. Admission to nay course is provisional.
3. Admission to the course cannot be claim as a matter of right and may be refused by the principal without assigning any reason thereof.
4. The decision of Principal regarding admission matters shall be final.
5. No intimation will be sent through post selection and will be published in the college website www.govtcollegesundargarh.org and in the college Notice Board.
6. For admission into First Year of different P.G. Courses available in the college categorization of candidates shall be done as below.
 - i) First Category- First Class Honours (60% above) in the subject applied for.
 - ii) Second Category- Second Class Honours in the subject applied for.
 - iii) Third Category- The candidates failing to secure Honours of 5% irrespective of subject i.e. securing 40% in the subject applied for.
 - iv) Fourth Category- All other candidates including Pass students and whose ranking is being made on the basis of aggregate mark plus marks in the subject.
7. Admission for Economics – Candidates securing mathematics Honours, B.Com Honours and Statistics Honours are to be placed just below the Economics Honours candidates in category (i) & (ii).
8. Admission for Odia Candidates- Securing Sanskrit Honours are to be placed just below the Odia Honours Candidate in category (i) & (ii). The cases of candidates who do not have Odia as an optional subject in B.A. will be considered after consideration of candidates of clause 10 in such cases the aggregate marks plus 3 times the marks secured in MIL(O) will be the basis for selection.
9. In case of equality of mark ranking will be determined on the basis of
 - i) Aggregate marks of categories (i), (ii) & (iii)
 - ii) Subject marks in category (iv).
10. In case of students who have passed compartmentally the average of the two marks in the subject in which the candidates have failed in the first attempt shall be considered for determining aggregate.
11. For admission to different P.G. Courses a candidate to secure minimum 40% mark in aggregate as well as in the subject concerned separately. However, for SC/ST candidates there is a relaxation of 5%.
- 12. Elective subject will not be considered for admission into P.G. Courses.**
